

REQUEST TO TEACHERS AND PARENTS FOR BOOK ON THE WRITING MISTAKES KIDS MAKE



Are you a teacher from elementary school to college or parent of a child from 5 to 20? Or do you know others who are? I'm collecting examples of the writing mistakes that kids make for a new book tentatively titled: *FROM THE PENS OF KIDS* to be published by Sasquatch Books in spring 2006. The mistakes can include anything from misspelling to misusing words to misquoting quotes or using the English language in unusual or inappropriate ways. They can also include humorous comments about history, science, math, literature, psychology, philosophical wisdom, politics, and other subjects; excuse notes, fractured grammar, metaphors, and kids from another culture who make mistakes in learning English. I won't be using any names of the students, just indicating, where known, their age or grade and gender, and I'll be including credits and "thank you's" for submissions in the back of the book.
